

EPSB Membership conditions:

To be eligible for EPSB membership, players must be of English nationality (e.g., born in England), or have been continuously resident in England for at least three years.

Any player who has represented another country in international competition in the previous three years is not eligible to represent England internationally.

The EPSB reserves the right to waive these requirements in exceptional circumstances subject to the approval of the EPSB Board. English nationals living outside of England may be considered for membership at the discretion of the Board.

The EPSB reserves the right to decline individual membership where appropriate.

Criteria for exemption to EPSB Membership rules

Players must meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Player has refugee status or has fled from a country with a recognised ongoing armed conflict.
- Player has declared neutrality under the WPBSA conditions and does not represent any other nationality.
- Player is a junior (Under 18) whose family have moved to the England with view to permanent residency or for work purposes and has been resident in England for six months prior to application.

Players with membership under this exemption will still not be able to represent England internationally until they have met the criteria set out in the standard conditions of EPSB membership.
